

New Mexico First will organize a two-day town hall that will bring together people from around the state to develop practical recommendations on water use and policy. There will be many panelists and a keynote speaker to help set the context. Augustin Plains Ranch project director, Michel Jichlinski, will be a panelist at the event. The key issues will include:

- Meaningful long-range and crisis water planning
- NM's aging water infrastructure
- Conservation and reuse
- Water development including possible desalination

The town hall meeting will be located at the Marriot Pyramid North on April 15-16 at 8:30 am to 5:00 pm each day.
